In that stratum of, "the best of the best," FIT alumni have gained their unique distinction through successes in their professions, service to the university and contribution to their communities.

Dr. Jerome P. Keuper Distinguished Alumnus Award

Purpose:

The purpose of the Distinguished Alumnus Award is to recognize alumni who have made significant contributions to society, and whose accomplishments, affiliations and careers have honored the legacy of excellence at the university. The Distinguished Alumnus Award does more than honor its recipients. It also further illustrates the great value of the academic programs and student involvement at FIT, and increases the pride all students, alumni, staff and faculty have for our university.

Criteria for Selection:

Candidates for the Distinguished Alumnus Award shall have demonstrated accomplishments in the three distinct areas as outlined below. This distinction will be reflective of the university's core values—Integrity, Excellence, Leadership, Loyalty, Respect and Selfless Service to others.

The three areas are:

- **Professional Achievement and Career Distinction**: The candidate has attained a recognized prominence through his/ her efforts in education, industry, technology, the arts, government or other worthy endeavors that form a record of accomplishment impressive to the university, the State of Florida and the nation.
- **Service to Society:** The candidate has demonstrated integrity and a commitment to service through an interest in bettering the lives of others through volunteer efforts.
- Service and Support to the University: The candidate's deeds and actions reflect the importance of his/her educational training, pride in alma mater and loyalty to FIT, as demonstrated through their interest in and support of the university and the alumni association.

Eligible Candidates:

Eligible candidates shall have been enrolled in a regular course of study at Florida Institute of Technology.

Former students employed by the university, the Alumni Association or any other university supported organization are not eligible during their term of employmers of the FIT Alumni Association (FTAA) board of directors are not eligible during their term of service.

Florida Institute of Technology Alumni Association "GOLD" Award (Graduate Outstanding in the Last Decade)

Criteria for Selection:

Graduate of Florida Institute of Technology—nominee will have graduated within immediate past ten (10) years—with achievement in career, public service or volunteer activities that shall be deemed worthy of recognition and which have brought honor to the university.
